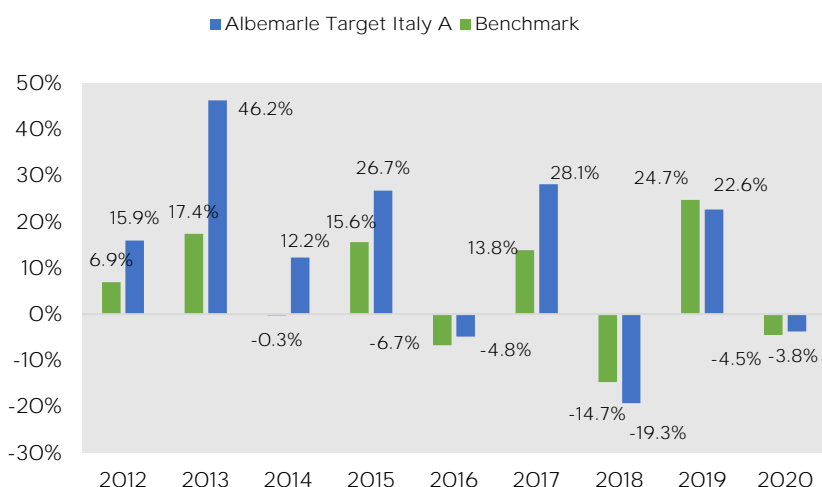

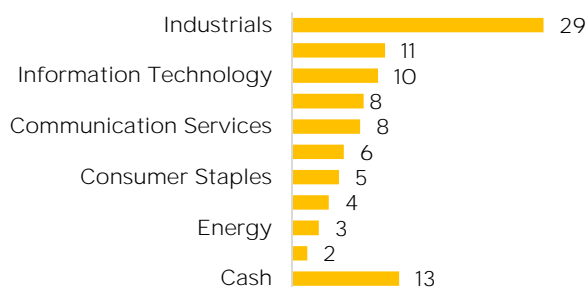

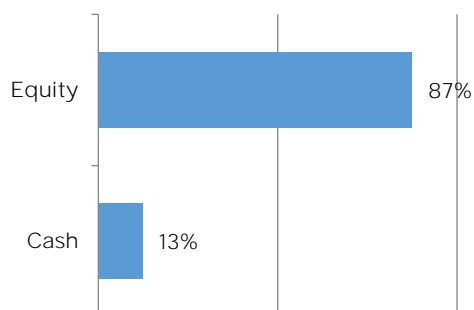

Asset Allocation Exposure

Investment Policy

Albemarle Target Italy is a long-only equity fund that invests at least 80% of its assets in equities with particular focus on Italian small-mid caps. The net exposure will be between 80% and 100% of the asset allocation. The fund adopts a bottom-up approach combined with a top-down overlay.

Commentary

The Fund posted another positive performance in December, strongly outperforming again the benchmark, mainly thanks to the good performances achieved by some of the main holdings. The main positive contributors to the Fund performance had been Esprinet, Fila, CNH Industrial, La Doria and El.en. Esprinet continued to rise given the good momentum and some analysts upgrading their target price on the stock. CNH Industrial continued to outperform given the increasingly positive outlook for the agricultural equipment market and the announcement of a new CEO. La Doria closed the month on a strong note as the Brexit deal concluded at the end of the month does not foresee duties on food import. The main detractors to the Fund performance during the month had been Piovan, Cementir, Pirelli, Buzzi Unicem and Leonardo. Cementir suffered some profit-taking after the very strong performance registered in November. Pirelli had been under pressure for technical reasons after the issue of a new convertible bond. During the month the main trades executed had been the sale of Esprinet, Tinexta and Digital Bros, and the purchase of Hera, El.en, Buzzi, and Pirelli.

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
