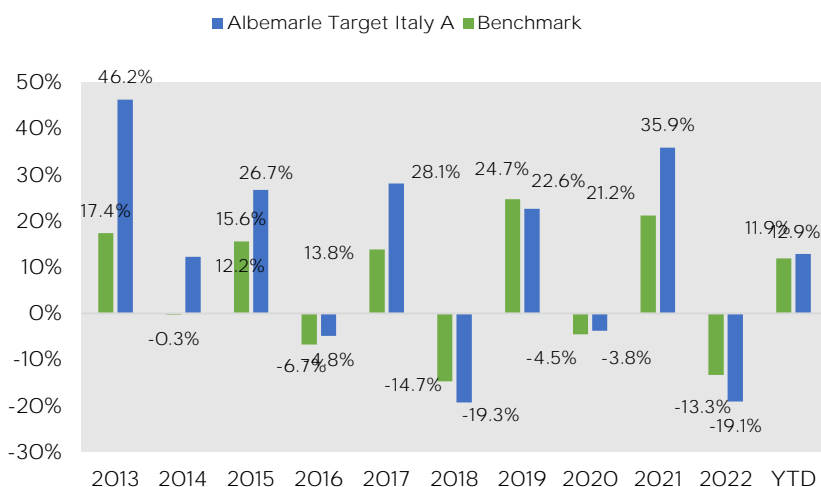

Asset Allocation Exposure

Investment Policy

Albemarle Target Italy is a long-only equity fund that invests at least 80% of its assets in equities with particular focus on Italian small-mid caps. The net exposure will be between 80% and 100% of the asset allocation. The fund adopts a bottom-up approach combined with a top-down overlay.

Commentary

The Fund started the year with a strong double-digit performance in January, and it outperformed the benchmark by c. +100bps. The main positive contributors to the Fund performance had been Saes Getters, Iveco, Piovan, Cementir and Technogym. Saes Getters gained over 35% as the company announced the disposal of the Nitinol business for a very high price (the asset disposed had been valued at a multiple of c. 17x EV/Ebitda). Iveco gained thanks to a brighter macro outlook, the announcement of a two important electric buses orders in Italy and Belgium, and an upgrade by a global bank. Piovan outperformed after the underperformance seen during Q4 2022. Cementir gained on the back of the strong performance of the entire building products sector in Europe. The only detractor to the Fund performance during the month had been Cembre, which had been penalized by some profit taking after the strong performance posted over the last months of 2022. During the month the main trades executed had been the sale of Saes Getters and GVS, and the purchase of Aeffe and Sabaf.

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
